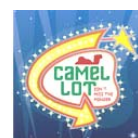

Your Assistance Is Needed To Bless The Detention Center Prisoners With Home-Baked Cookies!

Christian Renewal Church has the privilege of visiting the prisoners at the Glynn County Detention Center twice yearly: the Wednesday before Mother's Day and in December before Christmas. Every year we hear how much the prisoners enjoy the visit & most of all, the home-baked goodies.

We need to take in home-made, prayed-over, **HOME-BAKED**, sturdy, yummy and delicious cookies (not crumbly). Make sure they are thoroughly-cooled and brought to the church in disposable covered flat containers, (preferably aluminum pans or sturdy boxes, **please no zip loc bags**). Place wax paper between layers of cookies to keep them from sticking together. Label the outside of your box with approximately how many cookies it contains.

Please deliver cookies to the church Dec. 10 - Dec. 15. The gift bags will be delivered to the prisoners on Wednesday morning, Dec. 16, 2009.

Anyone willing to help with the packaging and praying over the packages come to the church at 4:00 pm on Tuesday, Dec. 15.
